Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Thomas Robinson, Son of the S. Joshua, out of the Cash I leave behind me and to be paid him by my Execut. hereafter named, Fifty pounds in maney, to him his Heirs and Assigns forever

Item I give and devise unto my nephew James Jones, Son of William to be paid him by my Execut. hereafter named the Sum of Fifteen pounds, out of the Money I leave behind me to him his Heirs and Assigns forever

Item I give and devise unto my brother-in-law Eli McCalley the Two hundred Acres of Land I purchased of a certain Matthias Jones and which lays near him the said Eli's with all the improvements and mefsuages thereunto belonging to him his Heirs and Assigns forever

Item I give and devise all the rest and residue of my Estate of what Nature and kind it may be and that I may leave behind me, unto my brother Phillip Marvel, my borthers in law Joshua Robinson and Eli McCalley, which is to be paid him by my Execut. hereafter mentioned, after and immediately when they have settled up my Estate with the Register of the County and desire it may be equally divided between them or their Heirs, to them their Heirs and assigns forever.

And Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Marvel and my brother Phillip Marvel Execut. of this my Last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills and Wills by me made heretofore by me made In Witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of October Anno 1793.
