

Alice Marvel, born May 17, 1772, who was married December 6, 1798.

David Marvel, born January 18, 1775, who died September 13, 1866, and married Elizabeth Gilder (1780-1825).

Philip Marvel, born February 9, 1779.

Chloeg Marvel, born May 10, 1782.

William Marvel and his wife, Sarah (P.) Marvel had ten children, one of whom was Mary Marvel who married James Shiles (son of Eli and Rachel (Cardiff) Shiles. James and Mary (Marvel) Shiles had a son, John W. Shiles, who owned land in Broad Creek Hundred, Sussex County, which had been left to him by his grandfather, William Marvel.

Thomas Marvel (1761-1801), son of Philip and Comfort (Rodney) Marvel, married Mary _____ and had a son, Joseph Marvel, who married Mary _____. (Joseph Marvel died in 1817).

Joseph Marvel, son of Thomas and Mary Marvel, and his wife Mary (_____) Marvel, also had a son named Joseph Marvel, who married Sarah Ann _____. Joseph and Sarah Ann Marvel had a son, Joseph H. Marvel, who was elected Governor of Delaware in 1894, but died about three months after he was inaugurated. Governor Marvel had two sons, Joshua G. Marvel and Joseph H. Marvel.

David Marvel and his first wife, Elizabeth (Gilder) Marvel, had fifteen children:

Rachel Marvel (July 25, 1818 - August 4, 1818).

Rembra G. Marvel (July 25, 1818 - June 23, 1851), married J. W.

Dill and had two daughters.

Harriet Marvel, born August 12, 1819, married D. D. Dunn (a grandson of Governor Dondal of Pennsylvania) and had a daughter who married as her first husband John Carter.

As his second wife David Marvel married Mrs. Ann (Berry) Lockwood on January 19, 1826. They had a daughter, Emma Marvel, born July 4, 1827, who died November 1828.

Mrs. Ann (Berry) (Lockwood) Marvel died in 1864. She was the daughter of William and Sarah (Leach) Berry. In 1803 she married Robert Broadway, who died in 1824. In 1816 she married Thomas Lockwood, who died in 1824. In 1826, as her third husband, she married David Marvel. Her father, William Berry, was the son of Joseph and Unity (Lowber) Berry.
