Whereas there is a certain tract of land lying in the said county in Nanticoke Hundred called "Bashan" and lying in the Great Neck and was surveyed to a Warren Burroughs in the year 1750 and cont for 530 acre by virtue of a proprietor's warrant granted to John Padmore dated at Philadelphia the 14th of December 1740 and after sundry conveyances became the property of John White and the said White did by his deed dated the 6th of March 1786 conveyed the same to the above named John Willis, now this indenture further witnesseth that in and for the sum of 150 pounds current money, Willis conveys and makes over to the above Heirs of John Welch, deceased the above mentioned part of the said tract of land bounded beginning at a red oak stump standing on the north side of the White Savanna and thence . . . to the beginning cont. 230 acres be the same more or less with all houses, orchards, fields, fences, timber, etc. belonging thereto.

Harris, deceased bounded beginning for the part to be conveyed at a red oak being a corner of the said Marvell's other lands and thence . . . through the said allotment . . . to a post in the line of the said allotment and thence . . . to the beginning cont. 36 acres of land more or less with all buildings and improvements thereon.
