MARVIL (p. 972)

Family of English and Scotch descent, many years in DE. Joseph Marvil m. Sarah Hopkins, res. Laurel. Children: William, Washington, Nancy, Martha, James and Joshua Marvil. All dec'd. (1899).

Joshua H. Marvil, youngest son, was b. in Laurel, 3 Sept. 1825. Businessman and philanthropist. Manufacturer and merchant. During the Civil War he was the enrolling officer at Laurel. He was elected gov. of DE 4 Nov. 1894, but d. in office after a few months. Joshua m. Sallie A. d/o John and Sallie A. Sirman. Children:

1. Joseph F. Marvil, b. 3 May 1851, res. Laurel.
2. Vandreth S. Marvil, b. 2 Nov. 1853, d. 12 Nov. 1891; m. Mamie H. Story (see her family below). One child, Joshua H. Marvil.
3. Joshua Dallas Marvil, b. in Laurel, 20 June 1856, in 1877 began business as a manufacturer of crates and baskets. Joshua Dallas was m. in Laurel, 3 Sept. 1888 to Sallie L. d/o John A. D. and Amanda Collins of Laurel. Member of the M.E. Church. Children:

STORY/MARVIL (p. 973 - 974)

George W. Story to the US from Nova Scotia and settled in Phila., employed in the US Navy Yard and d. in that service. His son, William A. Story, was b. in Phila., 6 Sept. 1820.

The Morgan family were early res. of Phila. William A. Story m. Elizabeth P. Morgan on 10 Jan. 1845, by the rector of Trinity P.E. Church of Phila. Children:

Vandreth was b. 2 Nov. 1853. (See family above.) Vandreth d. 4 years before his father on 12 Feb. 1891. Member of the M.E. Church. After his death, Mamie res. in Laurel, raising their only child, Joshua H. Marvil, who was b. 11 Nov. 1880. She is a member of the Baptist Church.

SMITH (p. 972 - 973)

Joseph O. Smith, to American from England and settled in Sussex Co., DE. He was a soldier during the Revolution. His children:

2. Joseph Smith, b. near Seaford in 1782. Studied medicine and practiced in Laurel for many years. Joseph served in the War of 1812. Col. Joseph Smith m. 1st Elizabeth Wingate of Laurel. After she d., he m. 2nd in 1847 to Lydia Earl of Bridgeton, NJ. Children, 2nd mar.:
 - i. Elizabeth Smith, b. 1847, m. Isaac H. Calloway, farmer of near Whitesville.
 - ii. George E. Smith, b. in Laurel 4 Aug. 1850, at age 16 began study of pharmacy in Laurel and in 1873 began the drug business for himself there. He has served in local political office. Postmaster of Laurel. George m. 10 June 1875 to Mellie d/o Benjamin F. and Mary E. Shepherd of Cedarville, DE. She d. 15 Aug. of the same year, of typhoid fever. On 12 Dec. 1878 George m. 2nd to Loletta M. d/o Dr. William J. and Mary E. Hitch of Laurel. Two children d. in infancy. Their only living child is Joseph Chandler Smith, who was b. 31 Oct. 1879, grad. from the academy at Easton, PA in 1895 and is now (1899) attending the medical dept. of the Univ. of PA. The Smiths attend the M.E. Church, their son is a member of the P.E. Church.
 - iii. Joseph F. P. Smith, b. in Oct. 1862, hardware merchant of Harrington. He m. 1st Mary E. d/o Joseph Moore of Bethel, she d. in 1886, leaving 5 children. Joseph m. 2nd Ida Ward of Harrington.
 - iv. Samuel T. Smith, b. 27 Sept. 1854, m. 1st Nancy Parker of Salisbury, MD, who d. of typhoid fever 7
